

Ground Investigation And Core Sampling To Establish The Environmental History Of Island House And Surrounding Areas

Island House Restoration Ltd have been undertaking extensive research with Aberystwyth and Lincoln Universities who have been conducting Ground Penetrating Radar (GPR) at several sites (see image below for the locations where research has taken place) in the Township following the Coran river and the foreshore and also to try and locate the historic town walls.

Gown Engineering has also aided in this area of research by providing us with core samples and identifying at what depth the natural bedrock occurs at the sites where the GPR has been carried out.

Island House restoration Ltd is committed to carrying out research as well as Archaeological investigation so that we can understand the natural and historical environment to help us better understand the origins of the building and how it played a role in the evolution of the township through the ages.
